Any adult who is on a low income and in receipt of one of the following means-tested benefits:

- Income Support
- Working Tax Credit
- Jobseeker's Allowance
- Council Tax Benefit (not sole occupancy)
- Housing Benefit

In addition, you may also qualify if you are a full-time student aged 16+.

How long is the **go!** Card valid?

The **go!** Card is valid for 12 months.



How do I get my **go!** Card ?
