

Tree and Shrub Donation Scheme

Information Sheet

- 1 Donations to cover the costs of planting trees and shrubs in Dunorlan Park are always welcome.
- 2 The Donation List shows the tree and shrub species, sizes and costs appropriate to Dunorlan Park. Only plants from this list can be donated.
- 3 The Head Gardener will be pleased to help you choose what type of tree or shrub to plant. The exact location of your donated tree/shrub will be agreed with you and your wishes will be taken into account whenever possible.
- 4 We will do everything we can to ensure your tree/shrub becomes successfully established in its new location, including watering and formative pruning as appropriate. This special care is usually necessary for the first seven years of a tree's life and the first three years of a shrub's life, and you will see from the list that donations are calculated to include the cost of planting and maintenance. After establishment, we will continue to carry out any necessary maintenance work at no additional cost.
- 5 If your tree/shrub should become damaged or diseased within the first seven years we will replace it with one of the same species if possible.
- 6 The Council keeps a Register of Donations which includes details of the donor's name, a short message and the location of the tree (no charge is made for register entries). The register is displayed on the Council's website (www.tunbridgewells.gov.uk).
- 7 For aesthetic and practical reasons, we regret that permission to install memorial plaques cannot be given.
- 8 Trees and shrubs will usually be planted between mid-November and mid-February.
